The MS column is reserved for employees with a Master's Degree in an approved program requiring 30-49 semester hours. An employee who earns an approved Master's Degree requiring 50-59 semester hours shall be initially placed in the MS+15 column. An employee who earns an approved Master's Degree requiring 60-69 semester hours shall be initially placed in the MS+30 column, and an employee who earns an approved Master's Degree requiring 70+ semester hours shall be initially placed in the MS+45 column. All employees with a Master's Degree may earn additional columns by completing approved graduate work equal to the number of hours between their desired placement and their initial placement. For example, an employee with a Master's Degree requiring 50-59 hours would initially be placed in the MS+15 column and would need to earn an additional 8 hours in order to move to the MS+23.
