Re: Adaptive Pause for BHAEC and Phoenix Programs

BHASED has made the difficult decision to take an adaptive pause and transition to remote learning for ALL students in the Center and Phoenix programs due to staffing issues related to COVID-19. This adaptive pause will take place from November 16th through Sunday, December 6th. Monday, November 16th will be a Remote Planning Day for the Center and Phoenix programs as we work to ensure we are prepared to provide remote learning to ALL of our students at the Center and Phoenix. Center and Phoenix staff should plan to report to work on Monday at your regularly scheduled time.

Students will not be in attendance on Monday, November 16th to allow teachers and staff time to prepare for this change, this will be a Remote Planning Day for Center and Phoenix students. All students will be transitioned to full remote learning beginning Tuesday, November 17th. At this time a pause to in-person instruction will be in place until Monday, December 7th.

It is imperative that while you are in the building on Monday that you strictly adhere to the safety guidelines that have been established and shared with you: certify upon entry to the building, wash/use hand sanitizer upon entering, wear a mask at all times, maintain 6 feet of physical distance between yourself and others to the greatest extent possible. If you are quarantining, have been identified as a close contact to someone with COVID-19, or have symptoms of COVID-19 please do not report to work. Do check your BHASED email as we will be hosting an all staff meeting Monday morning.

We hope to be able to return to hybrid learning very soon but this will depend on the status of COVID-19 in our area, staffing, and the guidance we receive from state and local officials.
