Dear BHASED Families and Staff:

The decision has been made to return to our hybrid model of in-person learning on Monday, December 7th. Please know that this decision was not made lightly and was made after much thought and consideration as we take the safety and health of our students and staff very seriously.

We know that our students engage best in person, need the consistency we can provide them at school, and have the best access to the programs and services they need to grow and progress academically, socially, and emotionally.

- If your child was on full remote learning before the adaptive pause, they will remain on full remote learning.
- If your child was following the hybrid learning schedule, you will have the option to continue with hybrid learning **OR** you may move to full remote learning through January 8th.
- Students can move to full remote learning at any time by notifying your child's building administrator.

A reminder that our hybrid learning schedule is as follows:

In-person Learning: Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, Friday from 8:00 - 1:30

Remote Learning for all students: Wednesday

We will continue to follow the guidelines and procedures established by the CDC, IDPH, and the BHASED Return to Learn Plan to keep all students and staff safe. We will continue to do our best to promote social distancing throughout the day. All students and staff will continue to be required to wear masks, and our enhanced cleaning and sanitizing procedures will resume as well.

Please trust that we will continue to monitor this ever-changing situation and communicate any changes that need to be made as soon as possible. We will continue to use our website, social media, robocalls, and text messaging to keep you informed.

As a reminder, if your child has any symptoms of COVID-19, is a close contact to someone who has tested positive for COVID-19, or if anyone in your household is being tested for COVID-19 you should NOT send your child to school.
