Position Overview: The Black Hawk Area Special Education District is seeking a passionate School Psychologist to support students and staff within our BHASED programs and member districts. The School Psychologist provides comprehensive psychological services to students ages 3–21 across BHASED programs and member districts. This role focuses on conducting psychological evaluations, supporting multidisciplinary teams, participating in special education eligibility and annual review meetings, and providing individual and group counseling services.

Responsibilities:

- Participate on multidisciplinary teams to address referrals to inter-district programs.



- Provide individual psychological evaluations as part of initial and re-evaluations of students 3-21 (inclusive).
- Participate in and assist in the development of initial evaluation, re-evaluation and annual review conferences as appropriate.
- Provide individual and group counseling to special education students as specified in the individual education programs.
- Provide individual and group consultation to special education staff and parents.
- Maintain such records and provide such reports, as may be required/requested.
- Serve as liaison among parents, individual schools, and other agencies for children with disabilities.
- Provide mental health consultation services to students in both special and general education.
- Serve as liaison between students and their families with community mental health agencies.
- Assist district staff in the development and implementation of the Multi-Tiered System of Support.
- Serve as a resource to district staff on academic and behavioral concerns as part of the Multi-Tiered System of Support.
- Performs other duties as assigned.
- This is NOT a supervisory position and DOES NOT include evaluation of colleagues.
- Participate collaboratively in BHASED psychologist department meetings.

Qualifications:

- Valid Illinois Professional Educator License (PEL) & School Psychologist Endorsement (SPSY).



- Master's Degree in Psychology, Educational Psychology, or an equivalent specialization in school psychology.
- Strong communication, organizational, and interpersonal skills.
- Ability to work collaboratively with a diverse group of stakeholders, including students, parents/guardians, teachers, staff, administration, and community members.
